Plastic Containers*

- YES** **Bottles and jugs**
Water, soda and juice bottles
Milk and juice jugs
Ketchup and salad dressing bottles
Dishwashing bottles and detergent jugs
Shampoo, soap and lotion bottles
- Tubs and containers**
Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups
Margarine, cottage cheese, cream cheese and other tubs
Clear berry and produce containers
- *Leave caps and lids on plastics.

- NO** Plastic bags and wrap
Styrofoam™
Microwaveable food trays
Motor oil bottles and other containers that held hazardous products
Toys, kiddie pools, plastic utensils, and garden hoses

Glass Containers

- YES** Food and beverage bottles and jars
- NO** Drinking glasses, ceramic dishes and vases
Window glass and mirrors
Light bulbs

Cartons

- YES** Milk and juice cartons
Soup, broth and wine cartons

Metal Cans

- YES** Food and beverage cans
- NO** Cans that held hazardous products such as paint thinner

Boxes & Paper

- YES** Mail, office and school papers
Magazines, catalogs, newspapers and inserts
Phone books
Boxes
Paperboard (cereal, tissue boxes)
Pizza delivery boxes
- NO** Paper soiled with food
Paper plates and cups
Paper napkins or towels
Gift wrap

Please empty containers and give them a good rinse.
